



New Household Hazardous Waste Collection Site Open

County residents now have a new location to bring household hazardous waste such as pesticides and herbicides, oil-based paints and stains, mercury-containing products, wood preservatives, and other old chemicals for proper disposal.

The new location is in Franklin at 10518 South 124th Street (2 blocks north of the Metro Landfill entrance). Hours are Tuesday and Thursday 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Saturday 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. (except holidays).

Three additional permanent sites are located in Menomonee Falls, Muskego, and Waukesha. Special one-day collection events are held in various communities in spring and fall. For a disposal guide and hours, visit the website at www.waukeshacounty.gov/recycling
