**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE
PREPARATION OF A COOPERATIVE PLAN WITH THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD**

WHEREAS, Section 66.0307, Wis. Stats., authorizes municipalities to enter into Cooperative Plans with the general purpose of guiding and accomplishing a coordinated, adjusted and harmonious development of the territory to be included in the Cooperative Plan, consistent with the Comprehensive Plan of each municipality; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Lisbon has determined that the best interests of the Town will be served by participating in the preparation of a Cooperative Plan in accordance with Section 66.0307, Wis. Stats., which Cooperative Plan shall include territories within the Town of Lisbon and the Village of Richfield; and,

NOW THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Lisbon does ordain as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED, that Town officials and staff members, acting under the direction and authority of the Town Board be, and hereby are, authorized to participate in the preparation of a Cooperative Plan with the Village of Richfield, which Cooperative Plan shall be prepared and submitted to the Department of Administration for review and approval in accordance with the provisions of Section 66.0307, Wis. Stats.




