### Garbage Collection Every Week

Please place in the TRASH containers:

- Mixed trash
- Broken toys
- Ceramics
- Bagged garbage & food waste
- Styrofoam & other loose trash

### Recycling Collection Every Week

Please place in the provided 32gal can:

#### MIXED CONTAINERS

- Aluminum cans & clean aluminum foil
- Tin cans, steel cans, aerosol cans, empty/dried paint cans
- Glass bottles & jars
- #1-7 plastic
- Milk cartons, juice boxes, soup cartons

#### MIXED PAPER

- Newspaper, magazines, books, mail, school/office paper
- Brown corrugated cardboard
- Gray chipboard (cereal & shoe boxes)
- Brown paper bags
- Shredded paper (bagged in clear plastic)

#### DO NOT put the following items in the green cart:

- Styrofoam of any kind
- Trash
- Construction materials
- Clothing
- Yard waste
- Household hazardous waste
- Electronics

Please do not put recycling in plastic bags. (see exception for shredded paper). Local clean sweep programs may offer alternative options for disposal of fluorescent light bulbs, household hazardous waste, pharmaceuticals and electronics.

### UP-THE-DRIVE SERVICES

- Both trash and recycling will be collected on weekly service via "Up-the-Drive Services".
- Please place all trash into containers or bags to ensure efficient and clean collection.
- Containers or bags must be placed in front of the home or garage for driver to easily locate.
- Place all recyclables (see other side for acceptable items) in 32gal container provided by Advanced Disposal.
- Please keep 6 ft of clearance between the containers and other objects, especially garage doors and parked vehicles.

### WEEKLY BULK COLLECTION

Items must be manageable by one person, not to exceed 50 lbs. If bulk items exceed the size/weight limits, or are appliances (refrigerators, stoves, washer/dryers), residents must contact Customer Care to schedule pick-up. Charges may be applicable for large items.

#### ACCEPTABLE BULK ITEMS

- Furniture
- Carpeting (no larger than 4 ft. and rolled)
- Extra garbage bags or garbage in personal cans
- Large metal items

All items for bulk pick up should be placed within 2 ft. of curbside.

#### UNACCEPTABLE BULK ITEMS

- Electronics
- Hazardous materials
- Liquid paint

## From the desk of the Town Chair Joe Osterman

Living in Wisconsin we are all too familiar with the changing of the seasons. Sometimes we experience all four seasons of weather within a couple days. While each season has its own unique appeal, the change from months of cold winter into the warmer weather of spring is a most welcome change. Change is something we have seen a lot of the past few years in Lisbon. We have seen some long-time employees of Lisbon retire as well as some Commission/Committee and Board members who have moved onto other adventures. This Spring we will say goodbye to two Board members that have given their time and talents to Lisbon for several years. Hannah Heinritz and Ryan Lippert will end their time as Lisbon board members in April. I would like to thank both Hannah and Ryan for their service to Lisbon and wish them the best in their future endeavors.

With the retirement of Joe Klemm in June of 2016 the board appointed Joe DeStefano, Jr. to the role of interim DPW Director. I am happy to report that in February the board has removed the interim title and promoted Joe DeStefano, Jr. to the permanent role of DPW director for Lisbon. Joe has shown over the past 7 months that he is the right fit to lead the Department of Public Works. Joe DeStefano, Jr., Administrator Matt Janecke, and the rest of the Town staff worked very well as a team putting together and implementing the massive road improvement projects of 2016. Joe and his crew have also done an excellent job of keeping our roads clear and safe this winter. Thank you to Joe DeStefano, Jr. for your hard work and congratulations on your promotion.

This summer will be another summer of road projects in Lisbon. The second half of the road improvement plan, approved by the electorate last year, will involve the repaving of 6 Subdivisions and 5 other roads. Spring Hill Subdivision, Circle Crest Subdivision, Colgate Road, Crooked Bridge Subdivision, Duplainville Road, Hickory Road, North Lisbon Road, Rolling Hills Subdivision, Oakwood Road, and Lynndale East and West Subdivisions will all be completed this year.

The 2016/2017 road improvement plan targeted Lisbon roads that were fast approaching the need to be completely reconstructed. The plan was to save these roads before they were too far gone and needed more costly replacement. Lisbon certainly has some roads that are past due for replacement. Town staff is working with our engineers to tackle the road projects in the order that will be most cost effective for Lisbon taxpayers. Staff has also been in contact with their counter parts in neighboring municipalities to plan future replacement of shared border roads such as Good Hope Road.

I wish everyone a warm and safe spring and summer.

## From the desk of the Building Inspector Bryan Oelhafen

All types of construction in the Town of Lisbon require a permit. This includes, but is not limited to, additions, remodeling, sheds, decks, and pools.

**From the desk of Director of Public Works Joe DeStefano Jr.**

Black boiler slag aggregate has been used in the Town in the past, and will be used this year as well. The Town has determined this is a very economical surface treatment that prolongs the life of Town roads by reducing the pavement deterioration caused by weathering. Timely preventative maintenance like this prevents costly street reconstruction projects in the future. We realize the inconvenience caused by limiting access to your street may be brief. Please understand that the inconvenience at this time is very small compared to what would later be required if this treatment is not applied. With your cooperation, it will be possible for the Town's contractor to complete the work quickly and with minimum inconvenience.

Black boiler slag aggregate is applied by using a thin layer of heated asphalt emulsion (oil) which is sprayed over the entire road surface and then covered by a thin layer of black boiler slag aggregate. The aggregate is rolled or pressed onto the oil layer many times by a combination of pneumatic (rubber) and steel wheel rollers. Vehicular traffic is allowed immediately onto the boiler slag after the rolling has been completed. This process may last for about thirty (30) minutes.

Once the road has been open, it is important for you to drive slowly and avoid any sharp turns or quick stops for about 7 to 10 days. Please be cautious when operating a motorcycle, bicycle, scooter or skateboard.

Most of the loose aggregate will be SWEPT & VACUUMED twenty-four (24) hours after the rolling has been completed. Some loose aggregate may remain on the street after the sweeping and vacuuming has been performed. Please be aware you may track some residual loose aggregate onto your driveway and into your house during this period. The Department of Public Works will be monitoring and performing future sweeping and vacuuming operations on an as needed basis.





### Mission Statement:

The Lisbon Fire Department is committed to maintaining a state of readiness to meet the needs of this community. The department is proud to be a leader among peer departments, approaching and overcoming challenges with determination.*

*The vision, simply stated, is that: The Lisbon Fire Department will provide the highest standard of EMS/Fire Service to our citizens, 24 hours/day, and 7 days/week, as allowed by the resources available to the Fire Department and at the lowest cost to Lisbon residents.*

### From the Desk of the Fire Chief Doug Brahm

With spring right around the corner, and hopefully soon, we want to take this time to remind everyone about burning regulations, and burn permits. Typically when you hear about Wildfires or Wildland fires, you think about out West (California, Colorado, Wyoming, etc.). In the State of Wisconsin in 2016, 14,027 acres of land was burned due to wildland/brush fires. In our region of the state, this poses a special problem. With rapid growth outward from urban areas, a lot of homes and communities are now in an area we call the Wildland/Urban interface. Homes and communities in these areas are especially at risk for damage from wild fires. Through your help, and diligent and responsible burning practices, we hope to avoid large scale incidents that may involve not only wildland areas, but residential/commercial structures as well. Burning Regulations may be found on the Town of Lisbon website, and on your Burn Permit which is issued with your tax bill and is of no cost.



Some of the provisions set forth are as follows:

- **The size of the pile may not exceed 4 feet, by 4 feet, by 3 feet high.**
- **The pile must be at least 50 feet from any structure, wood or lumber pile, or trees/bushes.**
- **Garbage, construction material, rubber/plastic/leather coated products, flammable liquids, or petroleum based products may NOT be burned.**
- **Must be attended at all times until extinguished by someone over the age of 16, and have readily accessible a garden hose capable of spraying water.**
- **No burning shall be permitted when the wind velocity exceeds 9 mph or local conditions make burning dangerous.**

These are the basics of the burning regulations and if you have further questions, please do not hesitate to call Town Hall, or the Fire Department. Again, you may find more information, and the entire ordinance on the Town of Lisbon website.

Motor vehicle crashes continue to be the leading cause of death and disability in America. Despite progress, over 40,000 people die annually on our roadways. Surviving a motor vehicle crash is dependent on the severity of the crash and the injuries incurred, but it is also linked to the knowledge, skills, and ability for rescuers to expedite a safe and fast extrication. Tragic vehicle crashes will continue to go on and on but together we can do better to ensure victim(s) of vehicle crashes are afforded a safe and fast extrication when their lives are in jeopardy!

The participants are rescuers who spend many hours practicing vehicle rescue techniques preparing for this opportunity to work with their peers and spend time with the top vehicle extrication specialists in the country. What they bring back to their communities is a wealth of information and newly refined skills, along with a stronger and diversified team of rescuers to better serve their community or assist another community during a crash involving victim(s) of vehicle entrapment.



**BRUSH PICK-UP**

The Town of Lisbon Public Works Department will begin the Spring Brush Pick-up on Monday April 17, 2017.

All brush must be out by the road at 6:00 A.M. that morning.

Only one pass through the Town will be made which will take approximately 3-4 weeks to complete. Any brush brought out after this time will not be picked up and will be the owner's responsibility to remove.

- No branches will be picked up that are over 8 feet in length. small branches should be tied together with string.
- Branches over 5 inches in diameter should be cut up and used for firewood.
- All branches should be neatly stacked with butt ends facing the road.
- The crew will not pick up from vacant lots or new construction.
- No stumps, railroad ties or landscape timbers are allowed.
- No garden or yard waste, bagged, boxed or other containers of brush will be picked up. Please take these items to the Compost Site.

**Please do not drop brush off at the Department of Public Works.**


We encourage you to take your small yard waste, plants and leaves to the Compost Site located on Plainview Road.

**RIGHT-OF-WAY ENCROACHMENTS**

The Town of Lisbon prohibits the placement of obstruction and encroachments within the public right-of-way. The public right-of-way is the land containing street pavement and the grass ditch line from the shoulder to the front of the property line.

- Obstructions are described as trees, landscape plantings, fences, posts, poles, temporary signs, bagged yard waste, or rocks.
