Motion by Steve Nuelk to approve an ordinance to reduce the speed limit on Oakwood Road from 35 MPH to 25 MPH and recommend to the Town Board of the same. Seconded by Randy Wittig. Motion passed 4-0.

Discussion and necessary action regarding a potential traffic study with Waukesha County for a traffic light on Lake Five Road and County VV.

Motion by Ed Brocker to recommend to the Town Board that the Town have a traffic study conducted with Waukesha County for a traffic light on Lake Five Road and County VV. Seconded by Steve Nuelk. Motion passed 4-0.

Discussion and necessary action to approve the addition of the crosswalk and signage on Plainview Road at the intersection of Plainview Parkway and recommend to the Town Board for approval.

Motion by Ed Brocker to approve the DPW to paint the crosswalk and change the signs on Plainview Road at the intersection of Plainview Parkway as outlined by Joe DeStefano's request and recommend to the Town Board of the same. Seconded by Steve Nuelk. Motion passed 4-0.

Discussion and necessary action on the request to place weight restrictions on Lake Five Road.

Chairperson Plotecher suggested that since the Committee does not typically address road weight restrictions, we forward this item to the Town Board without further discussion or action.

Motion by Ed Brocker to forward this item to the Town Board with no further action by the Committee. Seconded by Steve Nuelk. Motion passed 4-0.
