## **7. Unfinished Business.**

### **A. Stewardship Grant update;**

Park Superintendent Greiten read letter from DNR Grant Project manager Sara DeBruijn declining the town the grant based on final scoring results and the large request for funding at this time they are unable to offer grant assistance. Greiten read an email from town administrator Gina Gresch about a DOT Grant the park committee could go for. Committee Mayrack noticed that under the grants revenue funding outline there is a minimum project cost of \$50,000. The Lake Five road Bike/pedestrian path cost are around \$35,000 only. Mayrack wanted Greiten to look into if the town can even put in for this grant before we spend hours on the application grant process. Greiten said he would contact Tammy Hampton the funding specialist at Kunkel Engineering to check if this grant is even availability to the town and come back to the committee next month.

Committee talked about maybe asking the Lions and SAS clubs to possible donate money for the purchase of these trail cameras, Also Marlene and Scott along with Greiten should look into what trail cameras cost and what would be a good fit for the towns park security needs.
