

BEEKEEPING

Taken from the Town of Lisbon Zoning Code Section 3(i)(5)(AA)

Beehives as permitted in this Ordinance shall maintain minimum offsets and setbacks of 25 feet and shall be located behind the rear line of the residence or business as the residence or business faces the road.

In the A-3, A-5 and A-10 zoning districts, there shall be no limit on the number of bee colonies or bee hives on a lot.

In the AD-10, RD-5, R-1, R-2 and R-3 zoning districts, in recorded subdivisions, on lots one (1) to three (3) acres in size, two (2) bee colonies or hives are permitted; and on lots larger than three (3) acres in size there is no limit on the number of bee colonies or hives allowed.

In the AD-10, RD-5, R-1, R-2 and R-3 zoning districts, outside of subdivisions, on lots one (1) to three (3) acres in size, four (4) bee colonies or hives are permitted; and on lots larger than three (3) acres in size there is no limit on the number of bee colonies or hives allowed.

In the AD-10, RD-5, R-1, R-2 and R-3 zoning districts, whether in a recorded subdivision or outside of a recorded subdivision, on lots less than one (1) acre in size, no bee colonies or hives are allowed. In all other districts, no beehives shall be allowed on lots less than one (1) acre in size.
